Investigation Description: On November 10, 2011 Norm Eaton and I went to Wing Pointe to conduct a complaint inspection. While there we met with Cindy Neel and Danny Trexler. The complaint alleged that Wing Pointe was burning tires and dead birds. While onsite we observed a burn pile near the maintenance shop and bird pens. The burn pile contained several tires, brush and cardboard containers. I informed Wing Pointe that they could not burn the waste from the business onsite. Cindy Neel said that they would stop burning the tires, birds and other trash from the complex and that they would get a roll-off container in to clean up the burn pile.
A historical dump site was observed on the back of the property near the Reading Area Water Authority property. No waste appeared to have been recently dumped. I informed Cindy and Danny that no waste could be dumped over the embankment in the future, that all waste needed to be properly disposed of. A follow-up inspection was scheduled for the following week to observe the site clean-up.

No violations were noted and the incident will be closed.
